



Riverside Courthouse Remodel Riverside | CA

The Design Partnership provided space planning for a 40,000sf interior remodel of new judicial programs, architectural design and restoration services for the magnificent historic, 4 story, 1933 addition of the classic landmark Riverside Courthouse, built in 1903. The Riverside Courthouse is an architectural master piece with unparalleled ambiance and splendor that honors both justice and the City of Riverside, as one of America's most splendid Beau Arts Courthouses.

By co-locating new vital Court departments in the 1933 Addition of Riverside Courthouse, the building will now properly serve the public's needs. These departments include Judges' offices, civil and probate clerks, human resources, research, public assistance and support facilities for the adjacent Jail located on the upper floors.

Our vision transforms the central mechanical courtyard into a green sanctuary, water garden and public arts

program that will be located at its center. Envisioned as new center for justice, much like California's historic village square or America's town square, the new garden court will create a harmonious dialogue between architecture, landscape and the people that the Court will serve.
